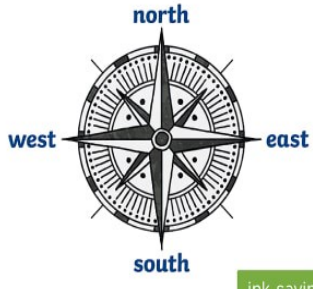
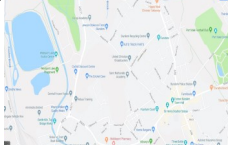

Vocabulary

address	Place where you live.	
city	A large town with a cathedral where many people live and work.	
compass	A piece of equipment that shows the direction of north.	
directions	Information on which way to go.	
map	A picture of a particular area of the earth drawn to scale on a flat surface.	
route	A road or course of travel from one place to another.	
town	An area with streets, houses, and buildings that is larger than a village but usually smaller than a city.	
transport	A way of moving from one place to another.	
travel	To journey from place to place.	
village	A small town or community, often in the country.	

Types of Houses



detached

A house on its own, no other house attached.



flats

A building with lots of floors and many houses within it.



semi-detached

Two houses, attached together.



bungalow

A house with no stairs, there is only a ground floor.



terraced

A row of houses, attached side by side.

toddler– A young child who is just learning to walk.

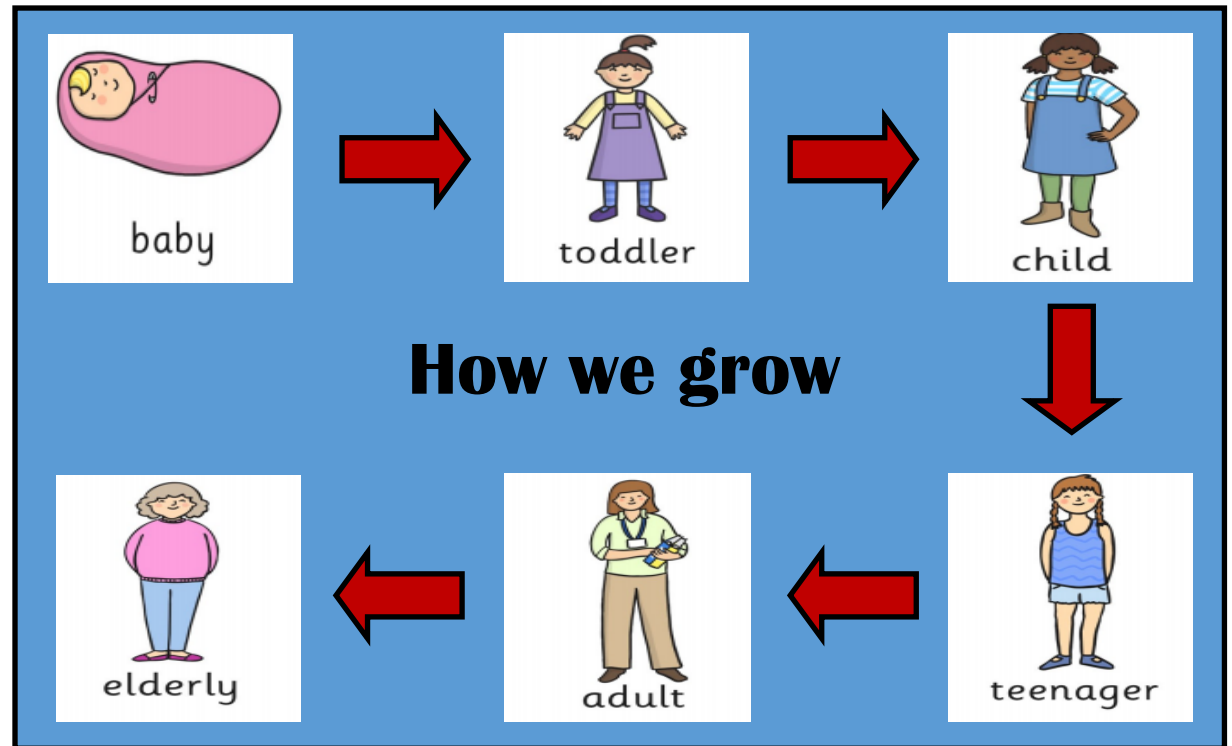
child– A young person.

- Count to 10 forwards and backwards.



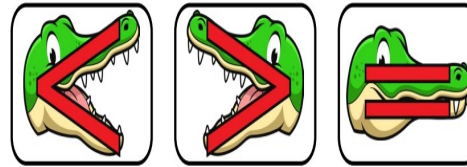
- Count one more and one less.



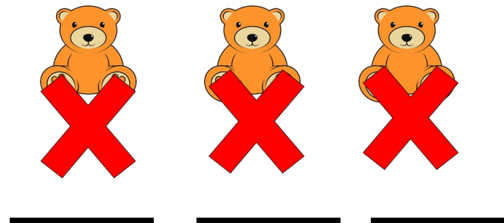
- Read and write numbers to 10.

Compare numbers using $<$, $>$ and $=$ for numbers within 10.

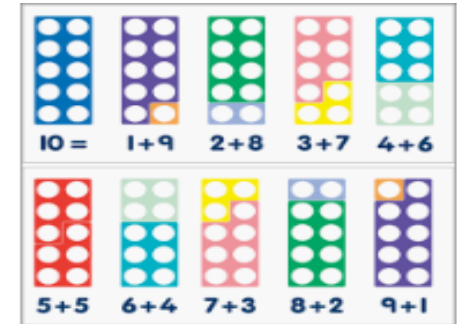


Count objects to 10.

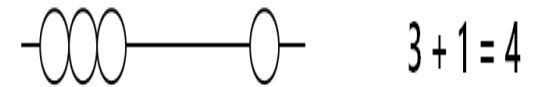


Addition and Subtraction

- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts to 10.

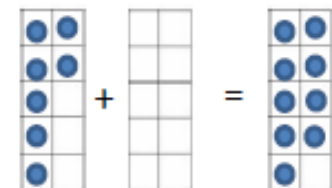


- Add and subtract one-digit numbers to 10 including zero.

Vocabulary

Add + Finding a total by combining two or more numbers.

$$1 + 2 = 3$$

Subtract - Taking one number away from another.

$$7 - 5 = 2$$

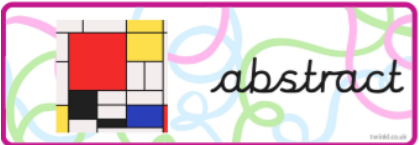


Mona Lisa (1503-1517)
