Being Imaginative

Phonics



R.E.

Literacy

The children will be reading about fictional stories on animals. They will be reading: Elmer the Elephant, The Tiger Who Came to Tea, The Rainbow Fish, Monkey Puzzle and The Snail and the Whale.

Mathematics

The focus of this term for the children will be re-capping their understanding of: height, length, size, weight and positional language. They will also be continuing with 'Ten Town', where they learn stories and songs about the different numbers and will be practising counting and number formation.

World

The children will be learning about seasonal changes during Spring, the weather and new life born in the Spring. We are focussing on, 'Animals' in this topic and will be learning about animals from all over the world, where they originate and their habitats.
